













Hingham Recreation Summer Preschool Program 2022

Dear Parents,

Hingham Recreation's summer program is about to begin! We are excited about the 2022 Preschool Summer Program and are busy preparing for your children.

- Your child is enrolled in Full Day Preschool which runs daily from 8:45am to 2:45pm.
- Children may not be dropped off prior to 8:45 AM and must be picked up promptly at 2:45 PM. Please be on time. If you arrive late, you may find a senior staff member on the premises and they will escort your child to their group. If you are running late for pick-up, please call the office at the Rec so that the senior staff members may be notified.
- Masks will not be required for indoor or outdoor activities. We suggest each camper brings a mask every day in case it is needed. We will encourage any children who are more comfortable wearing a mask to keep them on during the day.
- Please let us know if there is any change in medical information or telephone numbers. If your child is allergic to any food products please let us know immediately.
- All full day participants must pack a lunch. Children must also pack a small snack and bring a bottle of water every day.
- Only parents may transport children home unless there is prior written notification on file in the recreation office. A permission to release form is attached in this mailing. Carpools are encouraged but please inform us in writing of all arrangements. All adults picking up children will be required to present a valid driver's license.
- We have plenty to keep your children busy throughout the day. Please do not allow your child to bring toys from home; we are not responsible for lost items. Please mark all clothing and personal items with your child's name. They will play outside as much as possible and they will also enjoy water activities, music activities, arts & crafts and special shows.
- Please make sure that campers dress appropriately and are wearing sunscreen. We recommend that you provide a change of clothes, extra sunscreen, and a water bottle (all in a bag, labeled with your child's name).
- Please attach a visible label with your child's name on their backpack.
- All friend requests must be submitted by the Thursday prior to the start of camp.
- The drop-off and pick-up procedure for all campers is as follows:

At drop-off, parents are required to park their car in Haley Field parking lot and walk their child over to the counselors. Counselors will be waiting on the baseball field. At pick-up, counselors will be waiting with their campers in the same area. Parents must park their car in the same lot and walk over to the counselor. At this point, parents or those listed on the waiver must show their valid ID.
